The Divided Heart is an experiment in the use of literature as historical source material. Using combined methods of historical analysis and literary criticism, it examines fiction and poetry written by Scandinavians about their experience as immigrants in the United States in order to describe the complex psychological and sociological processes through which Norwegians, Swedes, and Danes turned into Americans. The author has fitted together hundreds of quotations from stories and poems into a vivid mosaic illustrating themes and patterns common to the life of this ethnic group as it developed and declined from the 1870s to the midtwentieth century.
