In order to maintain our original time table for conferences, we will hold our next conference in 1973. The excellent arrangements provided in Kungälv in the summer of 1971 have made us decide to hold also the 1973 conference at the Nordens Folkliga Akademi. The theme of the conference will be "The Urbanization Process Reflected in Social Science Research and Literature". We are planning the program now, and we intend to invite representatives for American urban history research as well as cultural anthropologists, sociologists, and economists. We will also treat the racial problem in modern cities as it is reflected in literature. The final program will be published in the next issue of American Studies in Scandinavia.

This time we are able to publish research concerning the fatal period when the cold war started. In an article about USA's relationship to Poland during the period 1943—1946 Geir Lundestad treats some of the complicated courses of events which led to serious tensions on the international scene. Also included is a small article which throws light upon Ranscm's poetry and another about the structure of the short story. Some of the findings of the Emigration Research Group, Uppsala, are reviewed. The Research Group deals with aspects on migratiqn phenomena Loth in USA and Scandinavia. It is concerned with the problem of making migration research an interdisciplinary study. As usual the issue contains a list'of recently published literature in the field of American studies from one of the Scandinavian countries, this time Sweden.

We are happy to inform you that we will send you, without extra cost, the Newsletter of the European Association for American Studies and American Studies published by the American Association for

American Studies with our periodical. In this way we can off considerably better coverage of what happens in the area of Amer Studies in the USA as well as in Europe.
